



## CONTACT LENS POLICY

The purpose of your annual contact lens exam is to ensure you have the best possible vision and fit of your contact lenses. This exam is done yearly to ensure you do not develop contact related eye problems. The contact lens exam is separate from the ocular health exam performed by the doctor and the refraction, which is the determination of your eyeglass prescription. Contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year from the date of exam and cannot be renewed without an annual examination.

A contact lens fee of **\$65.00** will be charged annually. This fee is not covered by your insurance company and payment will be required at the time of service. **This fee is non-refundable.** Initial\_\_\_\_\_

ALL CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTIONS EXPIRE ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THE EXAMINATION. THIS IS A FEDERAL REQUIREMENT AND WE ARE OBLIGATED TO ADHERE TO IT. If it has been one year or more since your contact lens exam or fitting, you will need a new examination to update your contact lenses.
